Strike in Sweden - Update



Dear Valued Customer,

We would like to give you an update and comment on the recent announcement from the Swedish Dockworkers Association about issuing a full strike for all its members as from 6th of March. We anticipate that several Swedish ports will be affected because of the strike. Our predictions of the future status per port is summarized below.

Gothenburg:

☐ Some impact – will closely monitor the development.

Helsingborg

☐ High impact – The port of Helsingborg will focus on the vessel calls, certain risk of move count restrictions. Truck- and Rail gate will remain open with predicted increased waiting time.

Norrköping:

☐ Minor impact – Small risk of increased waiting time at the gate.

Stockholms Frihamn:

☐ High impact – Next week's call will be processed as usual but with reduced speed. Following call the week after is predicted to encounter major issues, we will closely monitor the development. Truck- and Rail gate will remain open with predicted increased waiting time.



Gävle:

- Minor impact – some risk of increased waiting time at the gate due to increased volumes.

Södertälje:

- Minor impact – some risk of increased waiting time at the gate due to increased volumes.

Sundsvall, Umeå & Piteå:

- No update at the moment, we will closely monitor the development.

Åhus:

- Minor impact – We are predicting that the pressure will increase due to volumes being shifted temporarily to Åhus.

Västerås:

- Minor impact - some risk of increased waiting time at the gate due to increased volumes.

We are constantly monitoring the situation and the development by having close contact with the ports. More information will follow from our side once we have further information. Due to the situation ONE will not absorb any extra costs as a consequence of the strike.
